

Chimes Creek Neighborhood Meeting



Earlier this month, the developer of Leona Quarry was found to be in violation of polluting Chimes Creek and fined on 3 consecutive days, on August 4, 5, and 6. It took the City four months to acknowledge that our complaints of muddy, smelly and foamy water were directly attributable to the construction activities at the Quarry.

The developer has so far disregarded basic preventive measures against storm water pollution as required by State and local codes; and appears to be charging ahead with the construction while ignoring a number of the requirements that they had agreed to in the Settlement and the Conditions of Agreement.

Please come to this meeting to find out what is happening, and to voice your concerns. The rainy season is approaching, and it is not clear how we will be protected against mudslides and additional flow and pollution in the storm drains.

Turn at first left to Pine Top Rd. (it's marked) and go past the Founders Common to the Corp Yard.
